

Anglican Forth Day (A4D)

A4D is a renewal movement similar to the Cursillo week-ends begun in the 1940s in Spain, which now reach worldwide through many different denominational expressions.

The three-day weekend is a short course in Christianity where participants listen to and discuss talks given by both laity and clergy speakers while building community through various activities including worship services, singing and sharing.

These weekends are known for their good food and fun-filled times. But, more importantly, these days away from the participants' normal routines offer an opportunity for reflection and spiritually renewal.

We recently completed our 8th set of weekends since our beginning in 2006 and have had participants from most of the congregations in our Diocese.

Two representatives attended the Provincial gathering in Texas in August. Coordinators from each church chose representatives to the A4D Council which oversees our activities.
