PROTOCOLS

- 1) Sickness** - If, within 48 hours of September 23, your child has had a fever higher than 100.4, body ache, nausea, persistent diarrhea, persistent coughing, congestion, or sore throat, please keep them home and we will refund your registration fee.
- 2) Mobile Phones** - No mobile phones, or like electronic devices are permitted. Adult leaders will contact parents (or emergency contacts) in the event of a medical need or emergency.
- 3) First Aid** - A basic first aid kit will be accessible to all adult leaders throughout the weekend.
- 4) Drivers** - All drivers with students will be providing a copy of their license, registration and proof of insurance. No unplanned stops will be permitted to and from the locations listed, except in the event of an emergency, in which case Jack or Jordan must be contacted.
- 5) Adult Leaders** - In addition to Chad and Kip, additional adult volunteers (male and female) will be present throughout the weekend.
- 6) Two Adult Rule** - A student is not permitted to be alone and out of view with either one adult or one student. Students are never permitted to be out of view of adult leaders. In the event of injury or sickness, students will be accompanied by at least (2) adults, or (1) adult and (1) student.
- 7) Discipline** - Any student found misbehaving, bullying, physically or verbally inappropriate, disrespectful, or otherwise uncooperative, will be confronted and parents may be contacted to pick up their child from the premises. If a student is found using a phone, gaming console, or like electronic device, the device will be taken and returned at the end of the weekend.
